When exhibiting with the Texas Heart Institute, exhibitors are to meet ACCME guidelines for Commercial Support. Exhibitors cannot influence planning or interfere with the presentation of CME activities. Exhibit placement will not be a consideration of support for the CME Activity. No commercial promotional materials shall be displayed or distributed in the same room immediately before, during, or immediately after an educational activity certified for credit. Representatives of commercial supporters may attend an educational activity, but may not engage in sales activities while in the room where the activity takes place.

EXHIBIT SIZE: Exhibits will be tabletop displays only. Each company will be provided a 6-foot draped table. The display table will include one identification sign and two chairs.

REGISTRATION: There will be no registration fee for authorized exhibit personnel. Persons obtaining official name badges to host displays must be employees of the company sponsoring the exhibit. Exhibitor badges will be valid for admission to the scientific sessions.

EXHIBIT HOURS: Peak exposures will be during the breaks, breakfast, and lunch, determined based on the event.

SET-UP AND DISMANTLING OF EXHIBITS: Determined based on the event.
